Resource Advocates sought for a unique opportunity to collaborate with Community Care Clinic and the National Alliance on Mental Illness, North Carolina



(NAMINC) in Boone to support transitional services for people with mental health struggles and related wellness challenges.

A stipend of \$250 will be awarded to four people for approximately \$25/hr for ten hours of work. Resource Advocates must be reliable and trustworthy—references are required.

Resource Advocates will teach life skills classes or assist clients in accessing resources. Resource Advocates will be on a flexible schedule and expected to submit reports. Assignments will be based on Resource Advocates' skill set and career development goals. The collaborative will provide training in concepts of eight dimensions of wellness, transition to Community Living, Community Inclusion, etc. SAMSHA and NCDHHS have funded this grant. The local NAMI affiliate, NAMI High Country, supports these efforts.
